**CANADIAN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT (CEPA) &
DOMESTIC SUBSTANCES LIST (DSL) (CANADA CEPA/DSL) –
STATEMENT**

Based on representations of the Suppliers of the Materials from which the Goods are produced, the Goods are, on the date of shipment or delivery, not manufactured to contain chemicals listed on the Virtual Elimination List under the Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999 (CEPA), Batch 1 through Batch 12 Challenge Substances or present in a form that requires notification under the regulation.

The Goods are given a special shape, surface or design which determines function to a greater degree than does its chemical composition. Inclusion on individual country chemical inventory lists is not applicable for an “article” or a “manufactured article”.
